- Fire Station #5, 1011 Mason - One of San Antonio's oldest fire stations
- The McBroom Home, 906 E. Carson - Built in the early 1900s
- The Rivera Home, 1814 E. Palmetto - Built in 1907 & formerly owned by the Wurzbach family
- The Bullis House, 621 Pierce - Built in 1870 and now a Bed & Breakfast Inn
- Lambermont, 950 E. Grayson - Built in 1894 and now an events venue
- The Ashcraft Home, 421 Mason - Built in 1894
- St. Patrick's Catholic Church, IH-35 & Willow - Built in 1895 to serve the growing Catholic population in the area
